Sub: Acceptance of Recommendations Kakodakar Committee Report - Recommendation No.13.3.

High Level Safety Review Committee (Kakodkar) vide Recommendation No.13.3 has recommended as under:

> "One training institute at the Divisional level should be nominated and upgraded for training to staff on Safety environment in the Railways. This institute should have animation films; general equipment, tools and gadgets used on Indian Railways, etc." (para 6.2)

- In this context, the Railway Administrations may identify at least one training centre in each Division under their control and advise them to upgrade those Training Centres as per the recommendation of the Committee and introduce the training programme for training of their staff on Safety environment in the Railways.
