Please connect Para 8.1.16 of Board's policy letter mentioned above regarding validity period of trials and time limit for obtaining approval of the competent authority after trials, for considering the recruitment of sportspersons against sports quota through Talent Scouting.

In this regard it is clarified that in the case of request for release of berth from RSPB's Talent Scouting Quota or for granting relaxation (if any, as per extant rules) by Railway Board for recruitment of a sportsperson through Talent Scouting; the one month validity period of Trials may be counted from the date of Trials of the candidate to date of obtaining approval of the competent authority, within Railway/Unit, for sending proposal to Board's office. Therefore, the proposal in this regard along with all required documents, information and after obtaining the approval of the competent authority, must be sent to Board's office within one month from the date of trials.
