It has come to notice that, on one of the Division an employee against whom a Vigilance investigation was going on, was allowed to take voluntary retirement, without obtaining vigilance clearance from Vigilance department.


In this connection, attention is invited to the instructions contained in para 1(1) (c) & (2) of Railway Board's letter No.E(P&A)I-86/RT-32 (RBE No.103/87) dt.6.5.87 circulated under this office letter No.EP 949/0 Vol.III dated 27.8.87 (P.S.No.160/87)

Further, para 11.2 of Railway Board's letter No.E(P&A)I-91/RT-2/Master Circular dated 19.9.91 (Master Circular NO.35) circulated under P.S.No.150/95 also stipulates that

"Acceptance of the notice in all cases by the authorities mentioned above will be subject to clearance by the Vigilance Branch and from DAR angle".

In view of these instructions and in order to avoid re-currence of the instance as mentioned in para 1 above, it is re-iterated that the DAR/Vigilance clearance should invariably be obtained while processing the cases of request for voluntary retirement.

This should be complied with strictly.
