Copy of Railway Board's letter No.E(P&A) I-2010/SP-I/TC-1 dated 24.02.2011 addressed to the General Manager, All Indian Railways and Others.

Sub: Recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission – Decision  
relating to grant of Special Allowance – clarification.

One of the employees Federation had made a request for revision in the rate of Special Allowance admissible to staff engaged in full time announcement work. In this regard attention is invited to the instructions contained in para 2 of Board's letter No. E(P&A)I-2003/SP-1/TC-1 dated 30.07.2004 vide which Special Allowance admissible to staff engaged in full time announcement work was discontinued. It is reiterated, that these instructions are still in vogue, and Special Allowance is admissible only for part time announcing work in addition to normal duties.
