Sub: Grant of financial upgradation under MACPs to the direct recruit Graduate Engineers of drawing Cadre – clarification reg

Kindly refer to Board's letter dated 28.9.1998 (RBE No. 223/98) regarding allotment of pay scales to Drawing Design and Estimating Staff, wherein interalia, instructions were also issued stating that Engineering Graduates recruited in the scale of Rs. 5500-9000 be promoted to the scale of Rs. 6500-10500 againt 20% DR quota on the basis of LDCE.

- 2. Subsequent to the introduction of the MACP Scheme, the issue regarding grant of financial upgradation under MACP Scheme to the Engineering Graduates recruited in pay scale of Rs. 5500-900 prior to 01.09.08 at par with Engineering Graduates recruited in pay scale of Rs. 6500-10500 has been under examination in consultation with the Department of Personnel & Training (DoP&T), the nodal of Government on MACP Scheme.
- 3. In this connection, it is clarified that Engineer Graduates recruited initally in the grade of Rs. 5500-9000 & promoted to Rs. 6500-10500 against the 20% DR quota in terms of Board's letter dated 28.9.98 ibid be treated at par with the fresh recruits in the scale of Rs. 6500-10500 w.e.f. the date they were promoted to the pay scale of Rs. 6500-10500 for the purpose of MACP Scheme.
- 4. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
